(Cont'd from front page) him of pedophilia. The right winger had a field day but the Europeans loved him. Hormel was born to the wealthy Hormel Meat Company heritage, founded by his grandfather in 1891. The family was often visited by celebrities such as George Burns and Gracie Allen.

Jim's finest achievement was the founding of the special gay collection that is housed at the San Francisco Public Library. Conservative politicians charged that he personally selected the materials for the library. But only the staff performs that function. His tenure was Ambassador to Luxemborg was an inspiring success. Hormel concludes the book by reviewing what remains to be done such as the repeal of the Defense of Marriage Act. James Hormel now has a loving partner, Michael Nguyen and is still just getting warmed up for future battles on the human rights front.

San Leandro Senior center is also increasing its efforts to provide visible representation of the LGBT community as well as LGBT elder educational opportunities for staff. In addition, Photovoice volunteers delivered a second presentation to the San Leandro Senior Center commission on April 19 and asked that the center declare June as LGBT Pride month. The commission was very moved and strongly considering this request. Photovoice volunteers will continue to work with the senior center in the hopes that a resolution be passed declaring June as LGBT pride month which would increase awareness about the issues LGBT senior face when accessing mainstream senior centers. 
